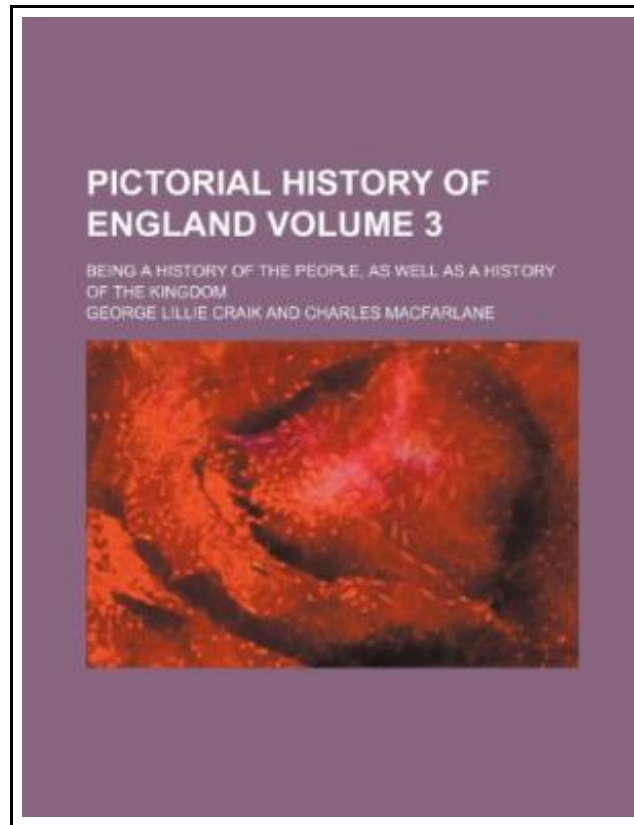

Its spirit is decidedly Calviuistic and anti-episcopal; the great Sco.tish refoimer, who had refused a bishopric from Edward VI., lays no restraint upon the expression of his cordial preference for a church divested of all worldly pomp, and of his scorn for the vain trifles which appeared to be held among the essentials of religion by the heads of the English establishment.
